2019 Vermont School Facility Person of the Year – Call for Nominations

For the eleventh consecutive year, the Vermont School Custodians and Maintenance Association (VSCMA) would like to identify and celebrate an individual as Vermont School Facility Person of the Year (previously, Vermont School Custodian of the Year). Principals, superintendents, and school board chairs are invited to nominate professional school facility staff, such as custodians, maintenance, groundskeepers, etc.

Qualified individuals will be current full-time school facility staff who have served in a Vermont school for at least five years and who exemplify the positive qualities of a hardworking, dedicated member of their school team. A committee comprised of the VSCMA officers will review nominations and select a deserving facility person for recognition prior to the end of the 2018-2019 school year. The award will be presented at the 2019 School Plant Operation & Maintenance Conference at Hartford High School, June 20th.

Nominations for the 2019 Vermont School Facility Person of the Year award should be in the form of a letter or packet of letters detailing the nominee's strengths, accomplishments, and contribution to her/his school team. Nominations may also include supporting letters from teachers, facility managers, school staff, students, and parents.
